



**King Mongkut's International Demonstration School Announcement
KMIDS Admission Examination Guidelines for Grade 7, Grade 8 and Grade 10
Academic Year 2018-2019 Round 3**

Under King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang's articles in re King Mongkut's International School, Section 10(4) 2016, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang released King Mongkut's International Demonstration School's announcement for Grade 7, Grade 8, and Grade 10 intake, academic year 2018-2019 Round 3.

1. Candidate Qualifications

1.1 Grade 7 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade level: *

- Grade 6 (American system)
- Prathom 6 (Thai system)
- Year 7 (British system)
- Standard 4 or Year 6 (New Zealand system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 6 of American system

1.2 Grade 8 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade level: *

- Grade 7 (American system)
- Mathayom 1 (Thai system)
- Year 8 (British system)
- Standard 6 or Year 7 (New Zealand system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 6 of American system

1.3 Grade 10 candidates must be currently enrolled in the following grade level: **

- Grade 9 (American system)
- Mathayom 3 (Thai system)
- Year 10 (British system)
- Form 3 or Year 9 (New Zealand system)
- Other education system's grade level that is equivalent to Grade 7 of American system

1.4 No serious medical conditions that may affect learning

1.5 Proficient in written and spoken English

1.6 Interest in mathematics, science and technology

***/** If candidate is currently enrolled in a grade level that is higher than those specified above, candidate may register and take the entrance examination. However, if the candidate is qualified for enrollment, the candidate must repeat another academic year. If candidate is currently enrolled in a grade level that is lower than those specified above, candidate could not register and take the entrance examination.**

2. Registration and Application Schedule Period

To provide prospective students and parents with a timetable for the KMIDS application, please use the following dates as guidance.

Once prospective students have confirmed and accepted the KMIDS offer, they will be officially registered into the KMIDS system. Afterward, **they will be invited to attend a pre-orientation in late July, where they will take a required placement test in English, Math, and Thai.**

4. Admission Fee

All candidates must pay the admission fee of 5,500 baht for Grade 7, Grade 8 and Grade 10. This fee will cover the cost of administering TOEFL examination at the test venue, remuneration for writing test graders and proctors, test venue fees and other operation expenses.

*** Payment must be made by 16 March 2018 at 12:00PM (noon)**

5. Registration Procedures and Details

Every student must go through this registration process:

- 5.1 Open www.kmids.ac.th and click "Admission" tab. Follow the instructions in the website. Fill in the information in the registration form. Print the registration form and pay-in slip (There will be a barcode on the pay-in slip).
- 5.2 Scan and upload the candidate's picture and an official transcript with at least the latest semester showing, according to the instructions on the website.*
- 5.3 Bring the pay-in slip and pay at SCB counter or at a counter service of your choice. Please refer to the barcode on the pay-in slip when making payment.
- 5.4 Take a photo of the receipt as proof of payment and e-mail it to info@kmids.ac.th with the name of the applicant shown.
- 5.5 The registration system will verify the payment and send an automatic response via e-mail.
- 5.6 The examination card will be sent on Wednesday, 21 March 2018 (three days before the test date) via registered e-mail.

*** If the candidate does not have the transcript of the latest semester, the candidate must present both certificate of student status and transcript of other semesters (within the last two years) as a substitute.**

6. Admission Process and Details

6.1 Candidates who have registered must go through the admission process at KMIDS. On the test date, candidates must present required documents to show proof of identity and registration. These documents are as follow:

- 1) Examination card which can be printed from the e-mail
- 2) The student identification card, national identification card, or other government-issued national card that has the candidate's picture. Only original documents will be accepted.
- 3) Official transcript of at least one **latest semester**. The transcript must be an original document and must be sealed (Only for those who have not uploaded the transcript onto the system)

***** Candidates who cannot present complete and proper documents will be disqualified from taking the entrance examination**

6.2 Examination - To ensure that KMIDS maintains its strive for excellence, assessments (as shown below) will be used to provide a review of prospective students. These assessments are mandatory and cannot be supplemented.

6.5 All candidates must arrive at the test venue at 7.30 a.m. in order to go through the check-in process before entering the examination rooms. All candidates must enter the examination rooms at 8.00 a.m. If the candidate arrives later than specified, the candidate will not be admitted into the examination room, and the registration fee will not be refunded in any case.

6.6 Only pencils will be permitted for writing and filling in the answers. Candidates must not bring other stationaries into the classroom. The school will be preparing the stationaries for all candidates. Other items such as wristwatches, cellphones, and other electronic devices are not permitted.

7. Admission Decision Release

7.1 The school will release the names of the candidates that are qualified to enroll on **Wednesday, 4 April 2018** via the www.kmids.ac.th. The school reserves the right not to release the student rankings and the examination results. Examination committee admission decisions are final. The school will only release the names of the candidates that are qualified to enroll.

7.2 Candidates who are not accepted into the school in this round may register for the next round(s) of admission.

8. Enrollment and School Tuition and Fees Payment

8.1 Qualified candidates for King Mongkut's International Demonstration School must confirm the KMIDS student status by making a full payment by **Thursday, 19 April 2018**. Payment details are summarized in the table shown below.

*** Security deposit and textbook deposit (70,000 baht) will be refunded after the student leaves the school

- **IMPORTANT:** Please note that fees related to food, transportation, dormitory, uniform, ROTC, student supplemental classes, club and calendar activities are **NOT included** in the school tuition. These additional fees must be paid separately and are due at the beginning of the year or at the time of the event.
- **Special Note:** Items No. 1 - 5 in the above table are **non-refundable**. Only textbook and security deposit may be retrieved if a student decides to not enroll.
- **Late payment will result in withdrawal of the student's name from the list.**

8.2 Qualified candidates along with the parents must be present on the enrollment date, which will be announced via the registered e-mail provided to the school.

All required documents, dates and times will also be announced via the registered e-mail.

9. Continued School Tuition and Fees

9.1 The school tuition and fees are paid **annually**. Details are as follow:

9.2 The school board of committee will hold a meeting to revise the school tuition and fees **triennially (every three years)**. This revision will be dependent on the economic conditions and operation costs at that time.

10. Candidates who cannot be physically present on the designated time and venue


10.1 Grade 7 candidates that cannot be physically present on the designated time and venue must abide to the following guidelines:

- 1) Present the TOEFL Junior, TOEFL iTP, TOEFL iBT, or IELTS results to the selection committee before **the designated test date.**
- 2) The selection committee will appoint a date for an interview of the students and the parents before **the designated test date.**

10.2 Grade 10 candidates that cannot be physically present on the designated time and venue must abide to the following guidelines:

- 1) Present the TOEFL iTP, TOEFL iBT, or IELTS results to the selection committee before **the designated test date.**
- 2) In the case where candidate is abroad, please contact the school to appoint an interview and a written examination date and time. The written examination will include mathematics, general science, aptitude test and writing test. The candidate must go through the admission process before **the designated test date.**
- 3) In the case where candidate is in Thailand, the candidate must take the entrance examinations at KMIDS. Please contact the school to appoint an interview and a written examination date and time. The written examination will include mathematics, general science, aptitude test and writing test. The candidate must go through the admission process before **the designated test date.**
